Seton Medical Center Coastside to Temporarily Close Facility including Standby Emergency Department services for Major Repairs Due to Storm Damages

Moss Beach, CA, March 7, 2024 – Seton Medical Center Coastside announced that it will temporarily close its Standby Emergency Department and acute care beds on April 1, 2024 until further notice for major repairs due to storm damages. The temporary closure was approved by the California Department of Public Health.

The decision to temporarily close the facility was made after a thorough assessment of the damages, which revealed the need for extensive repairs to the building's infrastructure. Seton Medical Center Coastside is working closely with local and state authorities, and construction teams to expedite the repair process and minimize disruption to services.

Seton Medical Center Coastside aims to reopen its facility once all necessary repairs are completed per the California building codes and safety standards and subject to relicensing of services by the California Department of Public Health.

During the closure, patients are encouraged to seek emergency medical care and acute care hospital services at the Daly City campus: Seton Medical Center on 1900 Sullivan Ave, Daly City, CA 94015.
