- Romanticized relationships highlighted through media.
- Youth who see/experience DV at home, are likely to experience in their own relationships.

2. Does your partner criticize what you wear, who you hangout with, how you act or how you carry yourself?
3. Is your partner physically aggressive when they are upset or angry?
4. Does your partner get jealous if you talk casually with another person?
